

Data Protection Notice

Your data

This notice is for all friends and members of the Church and those who have applied for membership; It applies to the processing of your personal data by the Church.

A Use of your data during your application to become a member

As a candidate to become a member, you consent to the processing, retention and sharing of your personal data for the purpose of assessing your membership application. You can withdraw your consent and request erasure of your data at any time prior to your initiation by notifying Deaconate that you wish to cancel your application. Your data will then be erased.

B Use of your data after you become a member

As a member your data will be processed, retained and shared for any reasonable purposes required by the Constitution of the Church or the bodies it sanctions from time to time.

Please contact the Data Protection Officer Mr Terry Worrall by post or email to if you wish to:

- 1. Object to the Church processing your data.
- 2. Request access to your data.
- 3. Request correction of your data.

The legal basis on which your personal data will be used is the legitimate interests of the Church as a not for profit membership organisation to act in accordance with the Constitutions and with this Data Protection Notice.

In this notice "Constitution" means the General rules of membership.
